

David Robeck CEO Bridge Counselling

Since October 2014, David Robeck has led Nevada's oldest behavioral health agency. By changing its focus from primarily substance abuse counseling to mental health and co-occurring treatment, Robeck succeeded in making Bridge one of the nation's first urban Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHC). He expanded his clinical staff from 11 to 50 duallicensed clinicians and added an on-site psychiatrist and psychiatric nurse practitioner. Bridge has now become the largest behavioral health nonprofit in the state with two Southern Nevada campuses (both CCBHC designated) and offering statewide treatment via HIPAA compliant Telehealth. He is a lifelong resident of Southern Nevada, excluding four years when he served as a Peace Corps Volunteer and development banker in post-Soviet Russia. Robeck has been a single father for over 20 years, having adopted and raised four special needs sons. He is the author of "Will Work For... The Untold Stories of Homelessness," a nonfiction book about poverty and homelessness. Robeck was a commercial banker for 25 years. He holds a bachelor's degree in finance and an MBA from UNLV.
